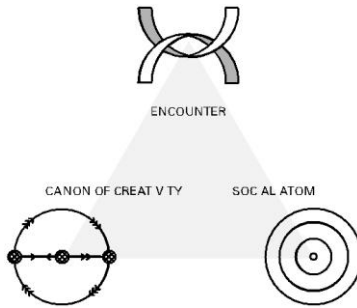

Since 2004 the Moreno Institute East has provided education and training in skills, tools and methods to advance one's life and work. Participants include schools, corporations, religious settings, business leaders, educators, life coaches, therapists, counselors, social workers, medical staff, clergy, activists, artists, lawyers, administrators, and community members.

The MIE offers a certificate of 100-Hour Training in the Morenean Arts & Sciences. Certification hours are recognized by the American Board of Examiners in Psychodrama, Sociometry and Group Psychotherapy. The curriculum is offered as a sequence of seminars over the course of a year, with a second year for those who desire the certificate. CEUs are also offered. We begin in November and end in May. Each of the seven seminars include: readings, presentations, education, and experiential training.

Individual Consultations

Available to all seminar participants. For those interested in the 100- Hour Certificate, a minimum of three individual consultations during the November – May program are part of the requirements for the Certificate. Consultations are provided by phone or in person. Consultations offer a review of the material, support and additional education. Integration and application of the method and theory is emphasized.

Independent Study and Apprenticeship Study

In addition to the curriculum, an MIE independent study and apprenticeship may be arranged to address a specialized focus, a deepened exploration, a particular interest or facet of the curriculum. An independent study and apprenticeship study includes the designing forms of review, assessment and planning, with objectives, goals and plans of action.

The MIE Certificate requires both a written and an oral presentation to reflect successful integration, understanding and application of the methods, tools, and theory. Ed has been the recipient of the Neil Passariello Memorial Award, Zerka T. Moreno Award, Collaborator's Award as well as a Fellow of the American Society of Group Psychotherapy and Psychodrama. Ed is an adjunct faculty member at Lesley University Graduate School of Expressive Therapies, and is the co-editor of *The Quintessential Zerka: Writings by Zerka T. Moreno on Psychodrama, Sociometry and Group Psychotherapy*. Ed is a Certified Director by Zerka T. Moreno and Certified as a T.E.P. (Trainer, Educator, Practitioner) by the American Board of Examiners in Psychodrama, Sociometry and Group Psychotherapy. In 2007 Ed and Adam co-presented "Moreno's Vision for Healing Society" in Romania and at the 65th Conference of the American Society of Group Psychotherapy and Psychodrama. In 2007 they presented a training workshop at Rowe Conference Center titled "Facing Ourselves, the World & Each Other: Psychodrama, Spontaneity and Creativity." Ed is presently working with Zerka T. Moreno as an editor of her "Memoirs" to be published in 2009.

Adam has provided professional education and mental health services for teens, individuals, families, businesses and schools for 20 years. Adam began with the Moreno Institute East at its inception in 2003. Adam helped to complete *The Quintessential Zerka: Writings by Zerka T. Moreno on Psychodrama, Sociometry and Group Psychotherapy*. In 2006 Adam and Ed initiated the formation of a non-profit charitable foundation called the Zerka T. Moreno Foundation for Training, Research, Education. In 2007 Adam and Ed co-presented "The Zen of Psychodrama – The Mountain Top of Intuitive Psychodrama – Moreno's Global Vision" at the First Conference in Expressive Therapies in mainland China. Adam is working on a series of more than 100 poems that condense the theory and practice of the Morenean Arts & Sciences, currently with the working title "*The Haiku Codes of the Morenean Arts & Sciences.*" Adam is also involved with a major project of the MIE, involving the publication of an unpublished autobiography of Dr. J.L. Moreno, *Autobiography of a Genius.*
